#### Faith-

Possibly do cookies from Sobeys. Discussion with Colin Loiselle at the District Office in regards to how the distribution of ashes will take place.
- Town of Morinville asked students to be a part of a Pink Shirt Day Video.

Staffing- Miss Onneken away on Mat Leave. Miss O'Neill is taking her position temporarily until the end of the year. She is an Edmonton Eskimo Cheerleader and teaches a variety of all star levels. Miss Fagan in Pre-K on Tuesday's and Thursday's.

Parent Teacher Interviews on February 24 and 25 Virtual. Report Cards out March 25 Primeau info night with Grade 5's February 18

Surveys will be coming out soon from the District. Will be notified when they are ready.

Nutrition Grant- A little money has become available for students/families that require healthy food or support for accessing healthy food. Snacks are distributed by the staff as needed. Let the admin know if there are families that need support at home.

Sports Academy- Various outside vendors coming in to work with the Sport Academy.

Student Council- Grade 5 students. Students are coming up with a lot of ideas. Ideas for a possible Winter Carnival type of event for February Early Dismissal. Helping with filling out hearts that say what students love about SKT.

## Drop off and pick up Zones-

- Some roads do not belong to SKT but to the Town of Morinville, therefore we do not have access to be parking in those spots. Troubles with parents parking on the main road and blocking the turn around making it difficult for the busses to turn into the bus zone. With the busy roads, it is dangerous for students to be walking across the road and bus areas.
- Michelle- Finding it tight to turn into the bus bay and having to back up which is illegal for them to do.
- Cheryl contacted the town for signage for parking and how we can handle the parking situation
- Drop off zones becoming congested with parents stopping and walking their children to the door rather than "drop and go". Movement needs to happen in the zone. Maybe have a staff member there to move things along.
- Bus lane needs to be cleared from snow.

#### Calendar-

- Survey results: Maximize opportunities for faith engagement, student learning, and professional development. Full Day PD Days kept on Fridays. Staggered entry for the first two days. Fall break.
- 2021-2022: Start before Labour Day (August 31). Christmas Vacation December 20-December 31. Interviews in October. 1 half day will be in the calendar for a Health and Wellness opportunity. End June 29, 2022.
  - Feedback- Concerned about the early start and last finish with the early start in 2022-2023 school year. Christmas push back to December 22 and come back on January 3. ATA day after Halloween is positive.
- 2022-2023: Start before Labour Day (August 30). Fall break in November. Christmas Break December 26- January 6, 2023. End June 28, 2023.
  - Feedback- Question about Fall break and if it is positive feedback/necessary.
    Parents find this time positive and teachers find this as an asset for the teacher's mental health. Not sure if it matches other districts with fall break dates, but
    Trustee's are talking with other districts and doing what they are able. Half days/early dismissals are hard on bussing schedules.
